### INTERNATIONAL FORESTRY DAY: STREET PLAY



### NATIONAL STATISTICS DAY










### AUDIO BOOK AND E-BOOK REPOSITORY


#### **NUHRO LANGUAGE LAB**




### **8. Extension Activities**








# GENDER ISSUES IN SHAKESPEAREAN PLAYS






#### CATH SAVOIR -YOUNG SCHOLAR SCHEME PROGRAMME- SUMMER CAMP







#### 9. Certificate Courses




## RESEARCH APTITUDE


# **ANTI- DRUGS CAMPAIGN**








#### STAND OUT FROM THE CROWD WITH A PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION

#### EFFECTIVE PUBLIC SPEAKING


